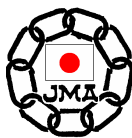

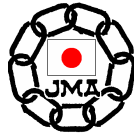

Nearest Airport: Narita (Tokyo)

From the airport to Kazo,,easiest way is:

- 1 Take Keisei Skyliner to the "Ueno"
- 2 At the "Ueno" walk to JR Ueno station.
- 3 Take JR Utsunomiya line to the "Kuki". (Pay attention to the destination. Those Koganei, Utsunomiya and Kuroiso are correct)

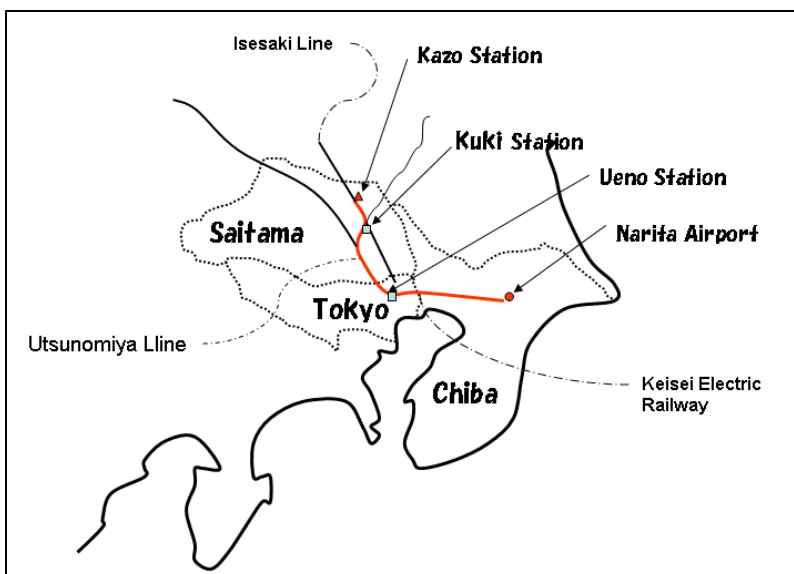

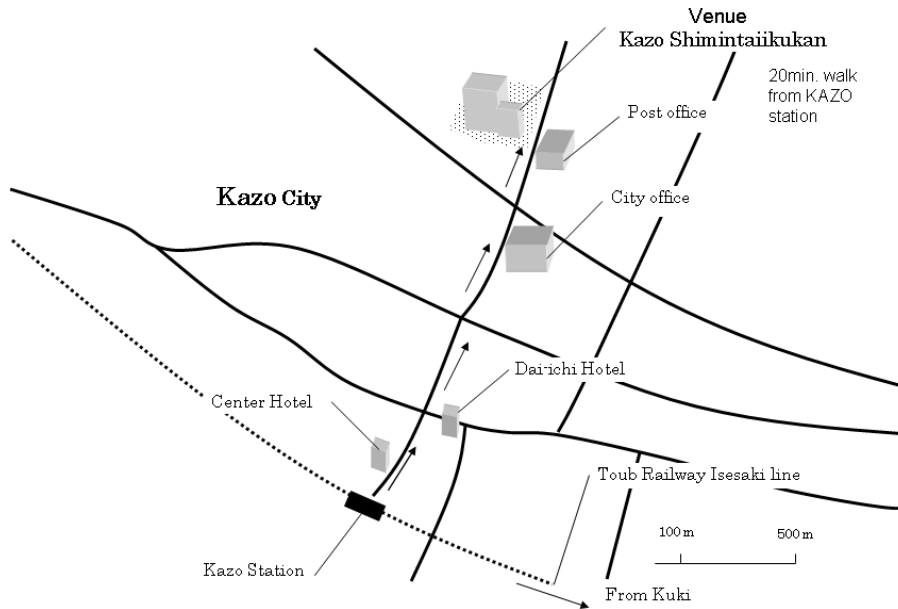
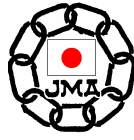
