Annual Commissions Meeting 2009 Barcelona, 21-22 November

1. World Championship

The EB agreed to shift the WCH to even years, starting from 2012; the 2011 WCH will take place regularly and will be followed the year after by another WCH. Deadline for 2012 WCH applications is 20th January 2010, and the election of the host city will be held in Bali.

2. WCH Disciplines

- a. Following the proposal by the EC to convert the actual combined ranking (medal, no event) into a new medal event, the EB agrees that it is premature to do so without prior testing and votes to keep the Combined ranking as it is for 2011 and 2012.
- b. The EB proposal to have the Combined Ranking medal converted into a new medal format in 2014, as long as it is successfully tested in 2010 (Combined Champion as per EC definition).
- c. Team Speed Relay: the EB agrees to introduce TSR as a new medal event starting from 2011.

3. Prize money

The EB agrees to the following:

Classic disciplines: Lead, Boulder and Classic speed – NO CHANGES

TSR: only medals, no prize money.

Combined Ranking:

- WCH 2011-2012-2014: prize money to 1,2,3
- WCH 2016 and on: prize money to 1 to 6

4. Demonstration in qualifications

Demonstration of the route in qualifications will be made through two different video sets; the video should be recorded in advance.

5. Calendar

Deadline for 2011 WC: 30 April 2010

Deadline for WCH 2012: 20 January 2010

Deadline for WYCH 2013: 20 January 2011

6. Anti-doping

The EB has approved the candidature of Paolo Orione as IFSC Anti-doping officer.

The EB has approved the constitution of a panel for procedural infractions connected to the AD testing composed by the IFSC Secretary General and the President of the Anti-doping commission.

The EB has approved the 2010 RTP as proposed by the AD Officer; the number of athletes has been increased to 30.

7. Commissions Members

The EB has approved the candidatures of Keith Ferguson (USAC) to the Events Commission and of Heiko Wilhelm (OWK) to the Coaches Commission.

8. Speed

The EB has approved a reform of the Speed Contract that will abolish the License and create a new procedure based on the homologation of the Walls.

9. Membership and Statutes

The EB agreed to propose to the PA the rewording of the Statutes (Art.6): Aspirant members will be defined "Associate"

The Observer status will be introduced; observer members will be presented by IFSC member federations.

10. Election of Secretary General

Deadline for submitting candidatures for the post of IFSC Secretary General is set at 31 December 2009. Election will occur in Bali PA.
