MUNICH – A MODERN CITY WITH TRADITION

The history of Munich is documented all the way back to 1158 when it was first mentioned as “forum apud Munichen”. The Old German name means “by the monks” and derives from the monks who ran a monastery at the place that was to become the Old Town of Munich. A monk is still depicted on the city’s coat of arms.

Today, the Bavarian state capital is the third-largest city in Germany – behind Berlin and Hamburg – and one of the most prosperous and fastest-growing cities in the country. It is consistently voted as one of Germany’s most liveable cities, with various career opportunities, a low crime rate, a broad selection of leisure and recreational activities plus an efficient infrastructure ensuring a high quality of life.

A METROPOLIS WITH SMALL-TOWN CHARM

Munich has become a household name around

the globe in various sectors, be it art, science, technology, education, or sports. The city houses many world-known brands, such as BMW, Siemens, Allianz, and FC Bayern Munich. There is a broad range of culture to be experienced in the 47 theatres and 46 museums, including the renowned Pinakotheken and the world’s largest technology museum, Deutsches Museum.

Till this day no building is allowed to be taller than the spires of the Frauenkirche (Cathedral Church of Our Lady), which unknowingly ensures that Munich does not feel as overwhelming as other cities of its scale. Various other factors add to the cosy vibe, from the city’s parks to Bavaria’s southern charm and famed beer culture. While the Oktoberfest nowadays often pictures a cliché, it is deeply rooted in tradition. When Crown Prince Ludwig married Princess Therese of Saxony-Hildburghausen in 1810, the citizens of Munich were invited to attend the festivities held in front of

the city’s gates, with horse races marking the close of the royal event. To honour their marriage the first Oktoberfest was held the following year and it has grown to what we see now over the centuries.

GATEWAY TO THE ALPS

Besides its touristic attractions, Munich boasts numerous green spots, with the English Garden alone covering 375 hectares! The Eisbach wave at its southern edge is probably the most famous river surfing spot and used by surfers throughout the year. With a length of 13.7 kilometres, the Isar winds its way through the city and offers additional recreational activities on its banks.

With its central European location and proximity to the Alps, Munich is the perfect destination for both city and nature lovers. The picturesque lakes and mountains are just a short drive away and provide the perfect setting for a weekend getaway.

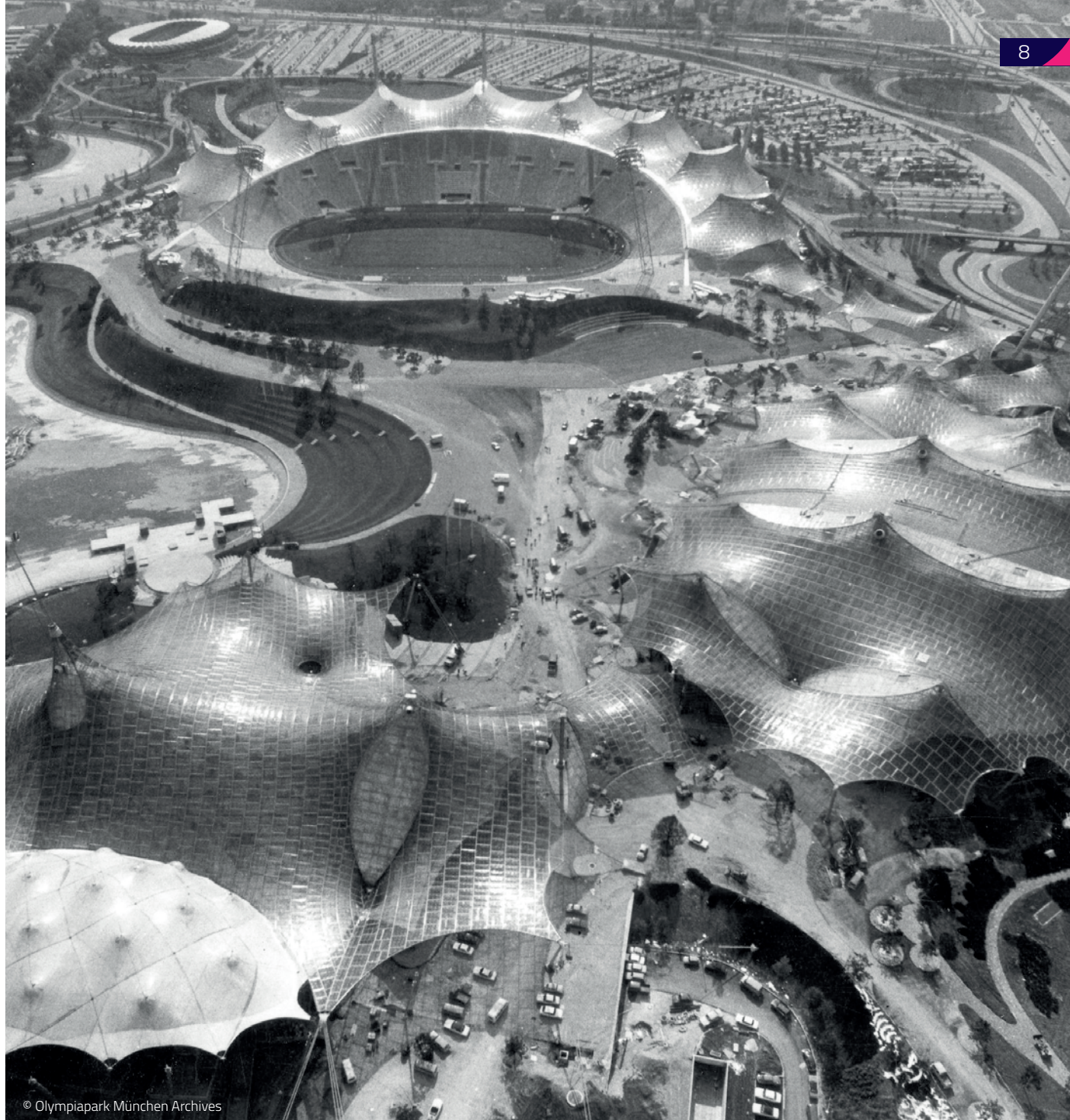

BACK TO THE ROOFS

Olympiapark München is an event location and meeting point with a glorious past, a vibrant present and a bright future. In August 2022, the park will once again be in the spotlight: By hosting the European Championships Munich 2022, Munich will welcome the largest sporting event since the 1972 Summer Olympics. High-profile sports 'under one roof', right in the heart of the city, in a carefree atmosphere – such is the winning formula for a unique and memorable experience. Back then, just as it is today.

Munich 2022 is an innovative return to the roots of the 1972 Olympic Games. A reminiscence of hospitality, happiness, and community, but also of the victims of the terrorist attack on the Israeli Olympic team. At the same time, the event is a return to a unique and historic place. It is a return to the legendary architecture of Olympiapark with its world-famous tent roof construction, which once turned Munich, seen as a village housing a million people, into an international sports metropolis overnight.

Munich 2022 pays homage to this heritage, celebrates the uniqueness of Munich as a venue, sets an example in terms of sustainability and leaves its own legacy. This is another, but certainly not the last chapter in the success story of Olympiapark.

EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED

Munich 2022 is more than just facts, figures, and sporting results. It is a holistic event experience, creating lasting memories in a light-hearted atmosphere. "The Roofs – Festival of Munich 2022" will significantly contribute to the eleven-day extravaganza. The festival of diversity and surprises will be accompanying the European Championships with a mix of music, culture, art, food and much more. It will turn Munich into the summer's place to be, with plenty to offer for young and old alike.

"The Roofs" is a festival for everyone. A place of encounter, participation, wonder and experience. Surrounded by the frenzy of the sporting competitions and accompanied by the charm and diversity of the regional culture.



The concept of pop-up experiences is creating a novelty setup and setting the stage – literally and figuratively – for the unexpected. The traditional event setup with the bundling of theme-specific contents in the same area is rearranged for “The Roofs”. Individually themed worlds – “Roofs” – will be created, each with their own character in terms of content and design. They will be spread across Olympiapark, Königsplatz and the Olympic Regatta Centre, allowing visitors and participants to

revel in a total of nine individual "Roofs" and delve into extraordinary experiences.

The programme is a tribute to 50 years of Olympiapark and symbolises the variety of this unique location, its history, present, and future. "The Roofs" conveys a small-town charm rather than giantism and focuses on uniqueness rather than uniformity. More to come. More to experience.

BACK TO MUNICH AND BACK TO THE ROOFS

No sport will come closer to fulfilling the Munich 2022 motto of “Back to the Roofs” than the IFSC European Sport Climbing Championships. On its 30th anniversary, the IFSC European Sport Climbing Championships make their third trip to the Bavarian capital city. This puts Munich on par with Chamonix as the city to have hosted the championships the most times.

Munich may provide the climbers with a sense of familiarity, but an all-new location awaits them with action set to take place close to the heart of the city in the world-renowned Königsplatz – home to the Glyptothek (archaeological museum), the State Museum of Classical Art and the Propyläen Gate. The square additionally makes up part of the wider

Kunstareal – Munich’s art and museum quarter which includes several other famous cultural institutions, as well as the Technical University of Munich.

Königsplatz is a popular summer location for friends to meet for an after-work drink on the sun-drenched steps of the Glyptothek. Once the sun goes down, the socialising moves across the square to the entrance of the State Museum of Classical Art, which on Friday evenings regularly transforms into a tango dance floor. The square is no stranger to hosting large scale events with a lively cultural programme that includes open-air theatre screenings and concerts taking place each summer. Hosting a major sporting event now adds to Königsplatz’s wide range of uses.

Placing the sport climbing programme in this iconic location guarantees high foot traffic, drawing an all-new audience to the sport. Spectators will be further encouraged by a number of sessions offering free entrance. The IFSC European Sport Climbing Championships share Königsplatz with the CEV Euro-BeachVolley, which will take place from 15-21 August 2022 and offer free entrance for certain sessions as well.

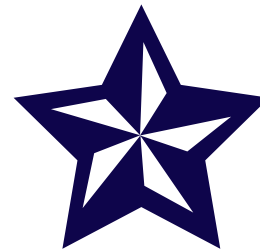

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The European Championships in Sport Climbing 2022 will run from 11-18 August 2022. Medals will be awarded in all four disciplines, Boulder, Lead, Speed and Boulder & Lead – each for women and men. The competitions will take place at the Königsplatz in Munich. The Warm-up Hall and Isolation Zone will be right next to the competition venue at school gymnasiums.

MUNICH 2022 EMS

With the Event Management System (EMS) Munich 2022 offers its users a platform to manage various services around the event in one place and in an easy and efficient way. The system consists of the following modules: Registration (accreditation application), Accommodation, Arrivals & Departures and Sport Entries & Qualifications and opens in February 2022. There are several ways of registration and management options depending on the groups. The following overview should provide a better understanding of the processes:

1. IFSC FAMILY

The IFSC Family will be registered by IFSC directly. For travel information and hotel bookings, it can be either done by IFSC or by every individual person by receiving a link to enter the system to manage their Accommodation and Arrivals & Departures data themselves.

2. TEAMS

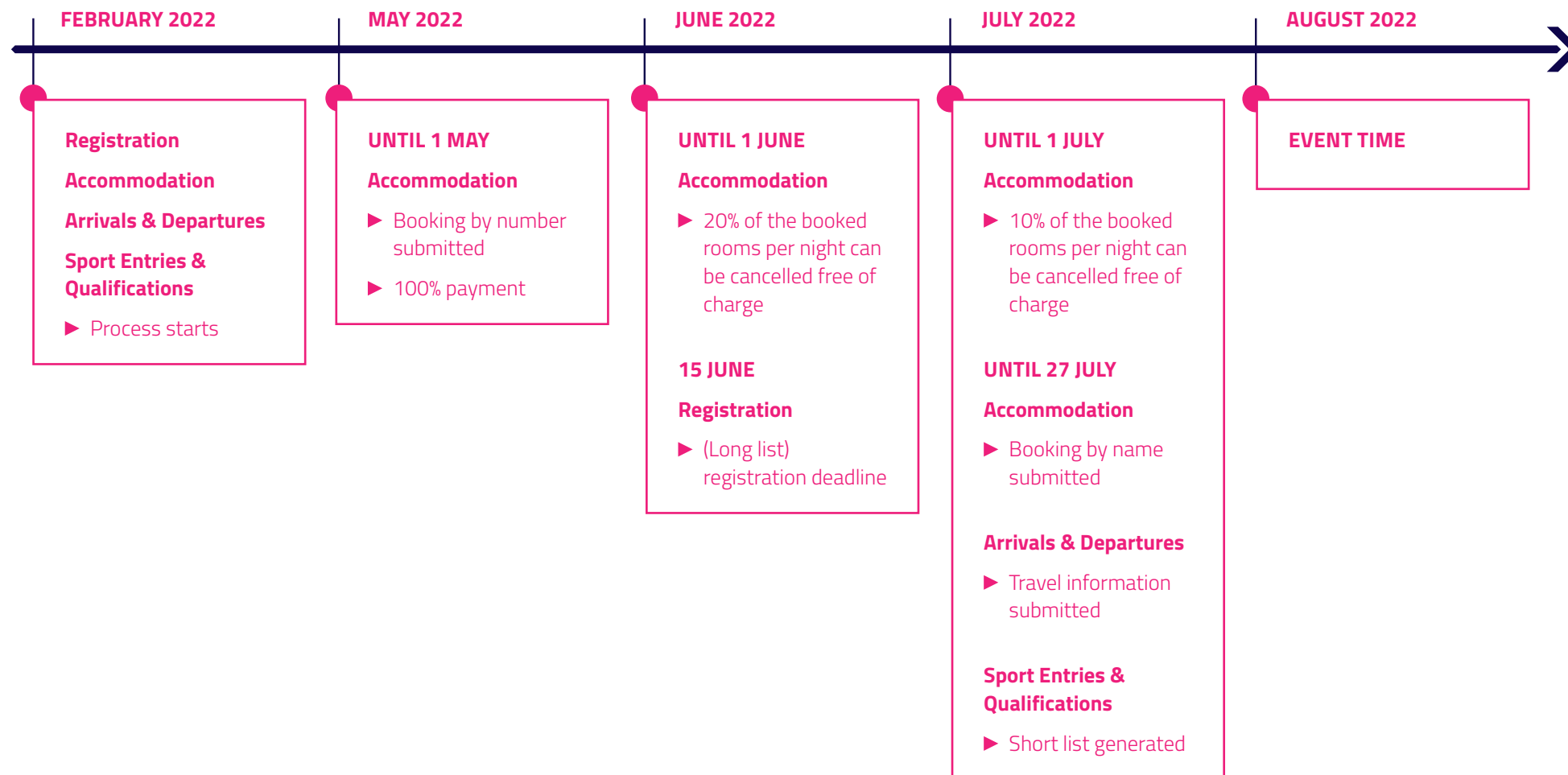
For teams there will be one single point of contact of each national federation who manages the registration as well as entering Accommodation and Arrivals & Departures data for all athletes and the team.

3. MEDIA

For media a link will be provided and communicated by the LOC and the IFSC for entering the system. Everybody belonging to the media group have to register themselves to get an accreditation.

Please note that the LOC will provide user guides with a step-by-step outline of the registration and booking processes before the opening of the system.

ALL DEADLINES AT A GLANCE





TEAM ACCREDITATION

Munich 2022 will operate with one accreditation system across all sports and all venues for the European Championships. All participants must be accredited for entering the sport climbing venue. Registration for accreditation through the EMS is mandatory for all teams, officials and the IFSC Family. Please note that photographs will be required during the accreditation process.

The Munich 2022 Main Accreditation Centre will be located at Olympiapark. We will also offer a Venue Accreditation Centre which is located directly at Königsplatz, and open for pickup during venue operations times. Team Managers are requested to collect the accreditation for their entire team delegation at the Venue Accreditation Centre and distribute them accordingly.

MEDIA ACCREDITATION

All media accreditations must be requested via the EMS, links for registration will be provided and communicated by the LOC and IFSC. The media portal opens in spring. The accreditation deadline for media is 30 June 2022. Media accreditation can be picked up at the Main Media Centre, located at the Olympiapark (opening from 8 August 2022).

TEAM TICKETS

In the spirit of the multi-sport event, accredited athletes and team members will have the opportunity to attend events of all nine sports free of charge. Please note that the number of team tickets available depends on the capacity and occupancy of the venues.

PLEASE NOTE: The registration quota for teams will be the same as for World Championships – two (2) Team Coaches per discipline per nation, two (2) Team Medicals per nation and one (1) Team Manager per nation.

The teams are kindly requested to proceed with the deposit payment within five (5) working days after the receipt of the invoice email, but not later than 01 May 2022 to guarantee the hotel booking. The invoice will be sent via email after the booking is finalised.

PLEASE NOTE: The accommodation booking will be guaranteed only after receipt of the full payment of the accommodation costs. In case the full payment is not received within the set deadlines, the reservation will be cancelled, and the rooms released. Cancellations within the applicable deadlines will be refunded.

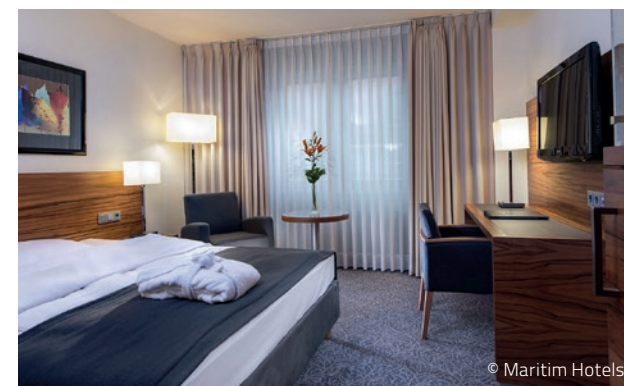

CANCELLATION POLICY FOR TEAMS

- ▶ **Until 1 May 2022**
100 % of the booked rooms per night can be cancelled free of charge
- ▶ **Until 1 June 2022**
20 % of the booked rooms per night can be cancelled free of charge
- ▶ **Until 1 July 2022**
10 % of the booked rooms per night can be cancelled free of charge
- ▶ **After 1 July 2022**
Cancellations made after that date – 100% of the total accommodation cost incl. meals will be charged – no refundable cancellation will be possible

For any cancellations made until 01 May 2022, no cancellation fee will be charged and 100 % of the booked rooms can be cancelled. After this date, only a percentage of rooms can be cancelled free of charge. The rest of the booked rooms cannot be cancelled and have to be paid in full.

You will be provided with a link to our EMS to enter your Arrivals & Departures details. The Arrivals & Departures portal as part of the EMS will open in February 2022, the travel details deadline is 27 July 2022.

Munich Airport Franz-Josef Strauss is located 32 kilometres (30-minute drive) from Königsplatz. You will be provided with shuttles from the airport to the hotels.

Munich Main Station is located about 800 metres (10-minute walk) from Königsplatz.

PUBLIC TRANSFER

All accredited teams, the IFSC Family and umpires will have public transfer included in their accreditation.

As the team hotels are very close to the competition venue and it is just one stop by underground transport there will be no additional shuttle from the team hotels to Königsplatz.

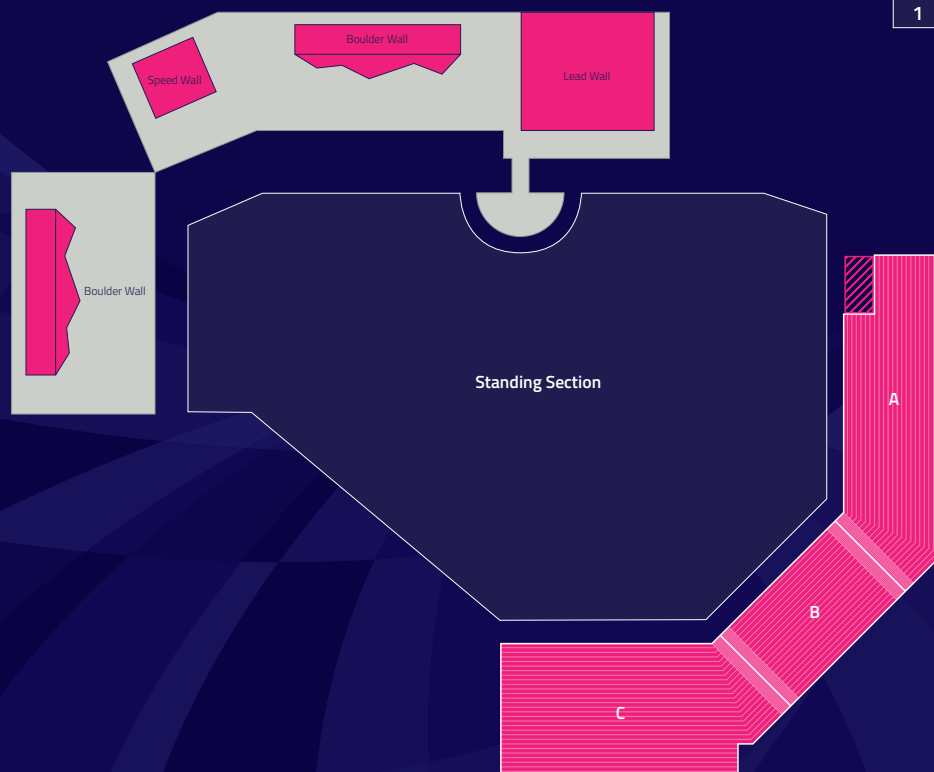
