INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE LICENCE 2024

OBLIGATIONS OF IFSC MEMBER FEDERATIONS

By applying for an International Athlete Licence, I, Member Federation, acknowledge the rules of IFSC. As a Member Association whose competitors apply for an International Athlete Licence I undertake:

- to inform IFSC immediately of any change of the Athlete's details given on the IFSC result system;
- to provide all whereabouts information concerning its Athlete required by the IFSC Rules or requested by the IFSC during and out of competition;
- to inform IFSC immediately of any adverse analytical finding from doping tests of any Athlete and of disciplinary proceedings in connection with such;
- to start, upon request of IFSC and without delay, disciplinary proceedings against any Athlete who has been subject to an adverse analytical finding from a doping test and to keep IFSC fully informed about the progress of any such proceedings;
- to ensure that the Athlete has been physically examined by a qualified medical practitioner and declared fit to compete in IFSC international Sport Climbing competitions;
- to constantly monitor the physical fitness of the Athlete, in order that the Athlete does not take part in competitions for which their health and fitness is in doubt;
- to ensure that the Athlete is fully and properly insured for personal accident and medical risks, including for repatriation.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- All Athletes (including youth Athletes, refer to the IFSC Rules for the category list) competing in IFSC international Sport Climbing competitions must be in possession of an International Athlete Licence issued by IFSC.
- Those Athletes for whom their belonging Member Federations have not applied for an International Athlete Licence or those who have not been registered for the relevant competition will NOT be allowed to compete in IFSC-approved events.
- The Member Federation agrees to comply with the IFSC REDs Health Certification policy. In case of failure to comply, the Member Federation accepts that sanctions and restriction to access competitions might be applied to the Athlete and/or the Member Federation.
- The validity of each International Athlete Licence expires at the end of the current calendar year.
- Each year, before the first competition of the season (or before the first competition of the season in which their Athletes intend to participate), every Member Federation shall apply for new licences or for the renewal of existing ones, in writing using this form. The forms shall be completed following all instructions included in the IFSC result system
- The 2024 annual International Athlete Licence fee amounts to 35 €/Athlete, for both new and renewed licences. These fees are to be paid upon receipt of the relevant invoice at the end of the season.
- All licences whose status is "confirmed" in the IFSC Result Service are included in the above-mentioned invoice, regardless the effective participation of the Athlete, and are subject to the payment of the relevant fee.

By clicking "I hereby confirm to have read, understood and agreed to the International Athlete Licence" on the IFSC Result Service, you are undersigning this document.

The Licence will be considered valid only when its status on the IFSC Results Service appears as CONFIRMED after both the Member Federation and the Athlete have confirmed it.
