DID YOU KNOW?

The environmental cost of making a T-shirt is larger than you may think. It takes the same amount of drinking water one person would consume in 2.5 years and over 2kg of eCO2 to make one single cotton T-Shirt. For example, currently 5% of carbon and water wastage in the UK is a result of clothing consumption. Alongside this a third of clothes in UK wardrobes have not been worn within the last year, this equates to a huge £30 billion of unused clothing.

With an estimated 300,000 tonnes of used clothing going to landfill in the UK every year, this is the same as 544,311,000 Olympic gold medals being thrown away. Instead please donate to: [trees not trees.](#)
