## IFSC Membership Application Form

- **Eligibility**

Membership of IFSC is open to national climbing organizations, uniquely representing climbing and climbing competitions in their country. In addition, the organization must:

1. Be organised with Statutes and Bye-laws acceptable to the IFSC;
2. Be open to participation without regard to race, colour, religion, national origin, gender, political views, sexual orientation;
3. Be controlled by its members according to democratic principles.

- **Application Process**

The IFSC Office welcomes applications for membership throughout the year. Once all the documents are received and in order, the application is submitted to the Executive Board for preliminary approval; the final confirmation will be ratified each year by the IFSC Plenary Assembly, typically March of the year following the application submission.
