IFSC CLIMBING WORLD CUP HAIYANG 2014: 3 DISCIPLINES, 6 PODIUMS FOR A GREAT ASIAN SHOW

This Friday, Saturday and Sunday, June 20-22, the 2014 IFSC Boulder World Cup Series pulled into its penultimate stop in Haiyang, China, while the 2014 Lead series kicked off and the Speed series picked up again after Baku! The competition is our first three-discipline World Cup of 2014, and there's sure to be something for everyone in the beachfront city of Haiyang!

The IFSC World Cup Haiyang 2014 is the only three-discipline World Cup, topped only by the World Championships in Gijón, Spain. Haiyang was the place to be this weekend for climbing fans of all stripes!

Two hard bouldering Finals

Jan Hojer was the only man to top 3 problems, following by the Canadian Sean McColl who topped 2 of them. The 4 other male climbers did not succeed in finding the right combination to overcome the 4 final boulders. Thanks to the bonus holds, Guillaume Glairon-Mondet climbed on the 3rd step of the podium.

If the female climbers got more success, none of them achieved to complete all four boulders. Akiyo Noguchi, Shauna Coxsey and Anna Stöhr performed better than the others and composed the bouldering females' podium. At the same time, they defended their place in the provisional 2014 ranking as follows: 1. Coxsey, 2. Noguchi, 3. Stöhr.

Faster and faster

For this third stage of the IFSC Speed World Cup, the female athletes did the same podium as in Baku with Mariia Krasavina first and Iuliia Kaplina second. Anouck Jaubert took the third place again.

On the men's side, China's Qixin Zhong, who ranked third in Baku, took gold in his home country, with Marcin Dzienski second and Danylo Boldyrev third.

Lead climbers entered the ring for the first time this season

For this first lead competition of the 2014 season, Jain Kim showed the way with an impressive climb that gives her gold. Austria's Magdalena Röck took silver and Belgium's Anak Verhoeven jumped in the IFSC World Cup podium for the first time in her career.

Jakob Schubert did a very good start with a first gold medal for the 2014 season as French's Gautier Supper did one of his best performances with a bronze medal here in Haiyang. Last but not least, Sean McColl won a second silver medal in 2 days and took the lead of the 2014 Overall Ranking.

Next stop: Laval (FRA)

The IFSC Boulder World Cup tour rolls into Laval, France, for its final stop before the World Championships in Munich! The same event kicks off the 2014 IFSC Paraclimbing Cup series with a top-roped Boulder competition! Our athletes will be giving their all in the idyllic backdrop of the small French city and its medieval vestiges.
