### IFSC CLIMBING WORLD YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS NOUMEA 2014:

### 400 YOUNG CLIMBERS COMPETE IN LEAD & SPEED IN WORLD YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2014 IFSC World Youth Championships will take place this September 19-23 in Noumea, New Caledonia. The up-and-coming talents in sport climbing will be present in this idyllic island cadre to battle for the World title in Lead and Speed!

The IFSC World Championships in Munich and Gijón were full of suspense, historic performances, and incredible spectacle. With nearly 400 young climbers participating in the World Youth Championships, we should be in for even more action and excitement!

### Incredible participation from the youth

Nearly 400 athletes from 27 countries from all the inhabited continents will flock to Noumea to experience its unique mix of French and Melanesian culture and climb on a state-of-the art outdoor climbing wall. Three categories, Juniors, or those born in 1995-1996, Youth A, those born in 1997-1998, and Youth B, those born in 1999-2000, will compete in both Lead and Speed competitions.

The IFSC is extremely pleased with this large turnout, as it proves that climbing is a popular and empowering sport for young people. Coupled with our recent participation in the Sports Lab at the Nanjing Youth Olympic Games in August, we are convinced that the youth are the future of climbing. This development has also been bolstered by many countries that offer climbing as a sport option in school. Climbing has physical, mental, and educational benefits, and we are proud to celebrate the spectacular performances of young climbers at these World Youth Championships in Noumea.

### Live coverage of all the action

Every stage of the competition, including the opening ceremony and qualifications, will be streamed on our homepage and YouTube channel. This is different from the other World Cup and Championship events this year, of which only the semi-finals and finals were streamed. This is a great opportunity for young talent to make a mark on the world stage and be discovered by climbing fans! Follow along on Twitter with the hashtag #ifscwych.

### **Host family program**

The IFSC extended its solidarity efforts to the World Youth Championships this year through a host family program. This program places athletes with families who provide room and board for them during the competition. This year, 18 participants from the Czech Republic, Ecuador, India, Mexico, and Poland will experience an island welcome from New Caledonian families!
