IFSC WORLD CUP TORONTO 2015

CROSSING OUT CANADA FROM SPEED TO BOULDERING

This Saturday and Sunday 30th and 31st of May the second 2015 World Cup competition will take place in Toronto, Canada. We are crossing out the second largest country in the world, from the west coast to the east to continue this IFSC World Cup Series. This time will be bouldering, and we couldn't be more excited.

Fierce competition demands harder boulders

In May 30th and 31st the world's best boulderers will meet in Toronto, Canada to give their best and overcome any obstacles they may have in the competition. The problems are harder every year and it's becoming more demanding to make it to the podium.

22 nationalities will be competing in Toronto. Jan Hojer and Juliane Wurm, both European Champions in Innsbruck last week, and Akiyo Noguchi last year champion in bouldering, will have to push harder to keep that first place. On the women's side, some of the names participating are Anna STÖHR, Fanny GIBERT and Shauna COXSEY. In the men's field, Jakob SCHUBERT, and Sean MCCOLL.

Where is the second IFSC WORLD CUP going to be this year?

Toronto, the most populated city in Canada and also the fourth most populous city in North America, invites all stakeholders of sports climbing to join us in this bouldering match. The capital of the province of Ontario is the perfect destination for climbers due to their long lasting sports legacy.

For the first time the IFSC World Cup Toronto will take place in a new venue, the Thornhill Arena, located on Bayview Ave. This multisports center

offers a bigger venue than the one last year, perfect to the amount of spectators participating in the IFSC World Cup Toronto every year. The competition will be held in one of the two hockey arenas.

We cannot wait to see what the athletes had prepared for us. Who will be able to hold onto the podium this time?
