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## **IFSC Boulder World Cup 2012: Showdown in Munich**

**A weekend full of suspense and spectacular duels is coming up in Munich (GER) on August 25 & 26: In the last contest of the season (and at the same time the final rehearsal for the World Championships in September) the world's best climbers are competing for positions in the IFSC Boulder Overall World Cup 2012.**

Especially in the men's overall standing it's all about Munich. Kilian Fischhuber (AUT) and Rustam Gelmanov (RUS) are starting equal on points - what means: If Kilian Fischhuber ends up ahead of Rustam Gelmanov in this final competition, Austria's record holder and most successful competitive boulderer of all time will secure his already sixth Boulder World Cup overall win. If Rustam Gelmanov is placed ahead of Kilian Fischhuber, Russia's two-time winner this season will obtain his first title. In the women's competition all eyes are focused on the battle for place two. Both Akiyo Noguchi (JPN) and Great Britain's shooting star Shauna Coxsey are in contention for the 2<sup>nd</sup> place in this year's overall ranking. First place is already fixed: Reigning Boulder World Champion Anna Stöhr (AUT) celebrates her third Boulder Overall World Cup win after 2008 and '11.

### **Munich live and on the internet**

Already for the third time it's Munich hosting the final contest of the IFSC Boulder World Cup. Fans and visitors can be looking forward to a great event in the Olympiastadion: In 2011 more than 8.000 spectators followed the contest in Bavaria's provincial capital and ensured a heated atmosphere. The qualification for the Boulder World Cup Munich is taking place on Saturday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, the semi-final and the final are following on Sunday, August 26<sup>th</sup>, (start semi-final: 11.30 a.m., final: 6.30 p.m.). All climbing fans that can't be on site will be able to watch the competition live on [www.ifsc.tv](http://www.ifsc.tv).
