## **Xining After-Competition Report – 12-13 October 2012**

### **Big in China: Ernst, McColl, Bruckner and Kokorin are the winners of the IFSC Climbing World Cup Xining**

**A thrilling competition weekend in Xining signaled the start of the final phase of this year's IFSC Climbing World Cup! With Johanna Ernst (AUT) and Sean McColl (CAN) two contenders for the Lead overall World Cup celebrated their victories in China.**

In Xining it finally was the time for Austria's Johanna Ernst: After already three podium finishes in this year's Lead World Cup the third-place finisher of the IFSC Climbing World Championships 2012 celebrated her first victory of the season. Lead overall World Cup leaders Mina Markovic (SLO) and Jain Kim (KOR) were ranked second and third in China, so it's all up in the air before the last three Lead competitions in 2012. In the men's competition Canada's allrounder Sean McColl celebrated his second victory of the season followed by routinier Jorg Verhoeven (NED) and youngster Stefano Ghisolfi (ITA). Reigning world champion Jakob Schubert (AUT) came in fourth in Xining, Ramón Julian Puigblanque, current leader of the Lead overall World Cup, placed a distant 19th.

In the Speed competition team Russia showed it's top speed on the men's podium headed by World Cup leader Stanislav Kokorin, Evgenii Vaitcekhovskii and Sergey Abdrakhmanov. In





the women's competition France's Esther Bruckner made her debut on top of the winner's platform, Edyta Ropek (POL) and Maria Krasavina followed in second and third place.

The next East Asia stop for the world's best lead and speed climbers will be the IFSC Lead World Cup in Mokpo (KOR) coming up from October 20<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>. Further information and a detailed schedule on [www.ifsc-climbing.org](http://www.ifsc-climbing.org).
