East Asia #2: Mokpo (KOR) welcomes the world's best Lead and Speed climbers on October 21st – 22nd

Just in time to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Korean Alpine Federation Mokpo in South Korea is the host city of this year's final Speed competition as well as the third to last IFSC Lead World Cup.

Torino, 16th October 2012 - Crunch mode is on in the IFSC Lead and Speed World Cup! In only four more weeks from now the World Cup 2012 will be history – the titles of the world's fastest climbers will already be awarded this weekend. A good bet for the men's Speed overall podium 2012 is Russian's leading trio Stanislav Kokorin, Sergei Sinitcyn and Evgenii Vaitcekhovskii. In the women's Speed final it's all about a Russian-Polish competition: Alina Gaydamakina (RUS), Edyta Ropek (POL), Yuliya Levochkina and Maria Krasavina (both RUS) are the four leading ladies after nine out of ten contests.

In the men's Lead overall World Cup Spain's Ramón Julian Puigblanque is leading the field after six out of nine competitions, followed by two-time winner Sachi Amma from Japan and Sean McColl (CAN), winner of the first prize in Xining last weekend. And the game is already





open in the women's Lead overall calculation: Mina Markovic (SLO), Korea's local heroine Jain Kim and Johanna Ernst (AUS) are the top 3 Lead women in 2012 so far.

Start of the Speed qualifications in the Mokpo International Climbing Center is on Saturday, October 20th, 5 p.m. local time, the Speed finals will be held from 8.30 p.m. (local time). The kick-off for all Lead climbers starts on Saturday, October 20th, 9.30 a.m. local time, followed by the semi-finals on Sunday, October 21st, 10 a.m. local and the finals starting at 4 p.m. (local time).
