



SLOVENIA GATHERS BEST CLIMBERS IN THE WORLD ON MAY 11TH - 12TH

After a premiere in the IFSC competition calendar at the end of April in Kitzbühel (AUT) a World Cup routinier is next in line: Already for the third time the Slovenian city of Log Dragomer is hosting the world's best climbers in the home country of Lead Overall World Cup winner 2012 Mina Markovic, Jernej Kruder, Klemen Becan and team.

Springtime is outdoor time - above all for climbing lovers: According to this motto the first out of two World Cup competitions in Slovenia this season (the final event of the IFSC Lead World Cup will traditionally follow in November 2013) will take place at the outdoor bouldering wall at the Sports Park Log, the biggest of this kind in Slovenia. In addition to the two-days of Bouldering competitions performed by the world's top climbers the accompanying programme brings a varied list of spectacular events.

And "spectacular" is also the exact description for the upcoming competition: Three-time winner out of three competitions this season, Anna Stöhr from Austria, will most probably again be the measure of all things in the women's competition, followed by her greatest competitor this season so far, Akiyo Noguchi (2nd of the World Cup ranking), as well as Shauna Coxsey and Alex Puccio. In the men's competition reigning world champion Dmitrii Sharafutdinov is still leading the field after his third place in Kitzbühel ahead of a constantly strong Guillaume Glairon Mondet and Kitzbühel-winner Jakob Schubert.

The kick-off for the Slovenian finals is taking place on Sunday, May 12th, at 7:00 p.m. local time. All climbing fans that can't be on site will be able to watch the competition live on **www.ifsc-climbing.org**, the remodeled IFSC homepage also offering all dates, rankings and detailed schedules.
