

BEST CLIMBERS HEAD FOR TORONTO 2013: DEST CLIMBERS HEAD FOR TORONTO FOR UPCOMING IFSC BOULDERING WORLD CUP ON JUNE 1-2

Summer is just around the corner and half of the IFSC Bouldering World Cup 2013 has already passed! The first out of the three remaining Bouldering competitions is taking place in Toronto, Eastern Canada, on the first weekend of June.

All in all eight competition stops are part of the IFSC Bouldering World Cup season 2013. After a European tour leading the world's best climbers to stops in Millau (FRA), Kitzbühel (AUT), Log Dragomer (SLO) and Innsbruck (AUT) in April and May the World Cup competitors are going overseas again: Toronto, Ontario - Canada's most populous province - will be the venue of home World Cup number one Sean McColl, winner of Log Dragomer and fifth of the current Bouldering World Cup ranking.

The run for first place is open

As previously announced, intermediate World Cup leader and reigning world champion Dmitrii Sharafutdinov will not be able to attend Toronto World Cup joining again the World Cup circuit at the competition in Vail/USA. A good chance for Jakob Schubert and Guillaume Glairon Mondet to make their run for the first place of the current Bouldering World Cup ranking. In the women's competition four-fold winner of the season Anna Stöhr is still leading the field after her second place in Innsbruck ahead of a constantly strong Akiyo Noguchi and Britain's Shauna Coxsey.

The kick-off for the Canadian finals is taking place on Sunday, June 2nd 2013, at 5:00 p.m. local time. All climbing fans that can't be on site will be able to watch the competition live on **www.ifsc-climbing.org**, the remodeled IFSC homepage also offering all dates, rankings and detailed schedules. So don't miss!
