





# IFSC BOULDERING WORLD CUP VAIL 2013: THE BATTLE WILL BE TIGHT

IN VAIL (USA) ON JUNE 7-8

Summer is getting close and there are only two more decisions left in the IFSC Bouldering World Cup 2013! This weekend, in Vail (USA), the world's best bouldering athletes are fighting for decision-making points in this year's last competition but one.

In the men's overall standing, everything will be played out in Vail - the struggle for podium finishes is sharp in this year's Bouldering World Cup! Reigning world champion Dmitrii Sharafutdinov is still leading the field (even after his absence at the last World Cup event in Toronto last week) 12 points ahead of third-place finisher in Canada, the Austrian athlete Jakob Schubert. All in all it is going to be a close call: The top seven of the current ranking - including Guillaume Glairon Mondet, Kilian Fischhuber, Jan Hojer, Jorg Verhoeven and Sean McColl - are separated by less than 100 points. In the women's competition all eyes are focused on the battle for places two and three. Constantly strong, the Japanese athlete Akiyo Noguchi is currently ranked second, followed by Great Britain's youngster Shauna Coxsey and local hero in Vail, Alex Puccio. First place is already fixed: Austria's boulder queen Anna Stöhr celebrates her fourth Bouldering Overall World Cup win after 2012, 2011 and 2008.

Excitement is guaranteed in Vail Bouldering World Cup. As part of the 2013 Summer Mountain Games and the only Bouldering event on U.S. soil the competition is known as a crowd favourite! The kick-off of the US finals will take place on Sunday, 8th June, from 04.45pm local time - to watch live on www.ifsc-climbing.org!
