

IFSC SPEED WORLD CUP: BAKU (AZ) WELCOMES THE WORLD'S FASTEST CLIMBERS ON JUNE 22ND - 23RD

The world's fastest climbers are back on the wall, fighting for records, points and victories: This upcoming weekend in the city of Baku, located at the crossroads between Western Asia and Eastern Europe, is the host city of this season's second Speed competition.

It's crunch time in Azerbaijan! After a three-month pause since the first competition of the year in Chonqing (CHN) the IFSC Speed World Cup is getting into its stride! In the only Speed competition in 2013 so far, Worldcup Overall winner 2012 Stanislav Kokorin was once again the fastest man on the wall in China, followed by Libor Hroza (CZE) and hometown boy Qixin Zhong. Poland's Aleksandra Rudzinkska carried off the gold medal in the women's competition ahead of Russian duo Yuliya Levochkina and Iuliia Kaplina. So high-speed and tension are guaranteed at the National Flag Square in Baku this weekend.

The kick-off for Speed qualifications takes place on Saturday, June 22nd, at 6.00 p.m. local time. The Speed finals will be held on Sunday, June 23rd, from 7.00 p.m. (local time). All climbing fans that can't be on site will be able to watch the competition live on www.ifsc-climbing.org, the revamped IFSC homepage, where you can also find all dates, rankings and detailed schedules.
