

## IFSC CLIMBING WORLD CUP 2013 : GAIDAMAKINA AND KOKORIN ARE THE WINNERS OF THE IFSC SPEED OVERALL WORLD CUP 2013!

**Thrilling action, a new female Speed World Record, and a total of five winners are the results of a fascinating weekend of climbing in Wujiang (CHN). Alina Gaidamakina and Stanislav Kokorin claimed their titles as the world's fastest climbers in 2013 winning the overall IFSC Speed Climbing World Cup 2013. The stage wins went to Kokorin and record holder Iuliia Kaplina in Speed, and Mina Markovic and Sachi Amma in Lead.**

After last Saturday, the speediest climbing nation 2013 is officially the White, Blue, and Red of Russia: only four months after setting a new female Speed world record at the IFSC World Cup in Baku (AZE) Russia's Iuliia Kaplina strikes again in Wujiang - twice! In the Semi-finals, the female World Games champion 2013, underbid her former world record of 8.05 seconds by 0.06 seconds, just to outdo herself again in the final round. With a vertiginous time of 7.85 seconds Kaplina won the day in China and at the same time set her third female Speed world record. On top of that, Kaplina's compatriots Alina Gaidamakina and Stanislav Kokorin (male winner of the day in Wujiang), the most constant Speed climbers of this season, celebrated their successes in the IFSC Speed Overall World Cup 2013. For the 23-year-old Kokorin it is his third title, also winning in 2010 and 2012, while Alina Gaidamakina celebrates her second triumph in the IFSC overall World Cup in a row.

Tension was also high at the Wujiang Lead competition. In the third to last Lead World Cup competition of the 2013 season, Japan's overall leader Sachi Amma was once again the man of the day in China. With his third victory of the season Amma retained his lead ahead of reigning world champion Jakob Schubert (third in Wujiang) and Spain's Ramón Julian Puigblanque who ended up in 17th place only in China. Bronze went to Canada's strong Sean McColl. In the women's competition serial winners Jain Kim and Mina Markovic are still fighting a hot duel for the overall title 2013. After her second place victory in Wujiang it's now again Korea's Lead constant Jain Kim leading the female field 10 points ahead of last year's overall champion and winner of the gold medal in China, Mina Markovic. 3rd place last Saturday went to Austria's youngster Magdalena Röck who moved up one place to fourth in the current overall ranking.

After three competitions in Asia the IFSC retinue is now returning to Europe. Next stop: Valence (FRA) where the second to last Lead World Cup of the ongoing season will be passing off from November 1st-2nd.
