





IFSC SPEED WORLD CUP: GOLD FOR GAIDAMAKINA AND HROZA IN ARCO!

Two new faces on top of the IFSC Speed World Cup winner's podium 2013 at Arco last Saturday: Alina Gaidamakina (RUS) and Libor Hroza (CZ) celebrated their personal Midsummer Night's Dream in the course of the Rock Master Festival at the foot of the monte Colodri.

Every year at the beginning of September the small town of Arco, known as the Italian hotspot for rock climbers from all around the world, catches the *Rock Master fever*. A weeklong celebration packed with great sports competitions and outdoor events attracts climbing champions and all those who love outdoor actitivies to the banks of Lake Garda. The first, and definitely fastest, medallists who smiled from the top of the IFSC Speed World Cup podium represented Russia and the Czech Republic.

In the women's competition reigning World Games winner Alina Gaidamakina made a clean sweep, dominating all duels right from the start. With a time of 8.78 seconds in the final the Russian champion won out over her compatriot, and winner of the silver medal, Mariia Krasavina. The third place winner was also colored White-Blue-Red in Italy: Bronze went to Kseniva Polekhina, followed by Anouck Jaubert from France in fourth.

Champions among themselves

In the men's competition this season's dominator so far, Stanislav Kokorin, had to leave the top of the World Cup podium for the first time in 2013. Reigning Speed European Champion Libor Hroza was the fastest man in Arco with a time of 5.99 seconds, 0.28 seconds ahead of reigning Speed World Champion Qixin Zhong (CHN). Stanislav Kokorin sew up the small final against Marcin Dzienski (POL) and won Bronze, his third medal out of three competitions in 2013.
