



IFSC WORLD CUP PERM 2013:

# PERM-ANENTLY ON THE GO: NEXT IFSC WORLD CUP STOP IN RUSSIA

No time for boredom is the order of the day for the world's sport climbing elite: Only one week after the last Lead World Cup in Puurs (BEL) the city of Perm is the venue of this season's first Lead and Speed World Cup competition in Russia.

Located about 1.150 kilometers north-east of Moscow the city of Perm houses Russia's highest indoor climbing walls (19,5 meters high and 6,5 meter overhang) - walls that will be highly frequented the upcoming weekend!

From September 28th to 29th the IFSC Lead and Speed champions are fighting again for decision making points at the Sport Center of Sucharev. Especially, Russia's speediest local heros Stanislav Kokorin, Alina Gaidamakina (current leaders of the IFSC Speed Overall World Cup 2013) and female record holder Iulia Kaplina. Tensions will also be high in the Lead competition: Ramón Julian Puigblanque and Puurs winner Jakob Schubert are starting their races to catch up with Japanese overall leader Sachi Amm. In the women's competition the leading ladies, Jain Kim and Mina Markovic are currently seperated by not more than five points!

#### Live and loud

The kick-off for the Speed finals in Perm will take place on Saturday, September 28, from 8.00 p.m. (GMT+6). The fourth IFSC Lead World Cup of this season is set to take place on Sunday, September 29, from 10.30 a.m. (GMT+6), final time set for 7.30 p.m. (GMT+6).
